I am excited to share with you CorpsAfrica's 2019 Annual Report. It was a successful year for CorpsAfrica with 130 Volunteers serving in four countries. The Exchange Program thrived as well, with a Senegalese Volunteer serving in Morocco, and Moroccan and Senegalese Volunteers serving in Malawi.

We continued to expand the model of recruiting universityeducated Africans to serve as volunteers in rural, highpoverty communities in Morocco, Senegal, Malawi, and Rwanda. We trained the Volunteers in Human-Centered Design, a problem-solving technique and structure to the facilitation process to help them the identify complex needs in education, environmental conservation, health, potable water and irrigation, business development, and more. The Volunteers integrated successfully into their communities by living with host families, learning local customs and languages, and participating in daily activities. They created change by implementing demand-driven sustainable projects in agriculture, education, health, infrastructure, and more.

It is a great honor to give young Africans the chance they deserve to lead Africa's development. Together we can create a model for national and Pan-African service and participatory, collaborative and accountable community development across Africa.
